



The Board voted to Support HB20-1017 and urges legislators to expand the language in regards to medication assisted treatment programs in jails, prisons, and the Department of Human Services facilities to be more encompassing by using “substance use disorder” instead of “opioid use disorder,” while also requiring at least one opioid agonist and opioid antagonist be made available. Additionally, the Board of Directors urges legislators to provide funding for entities to implement an effective MAT program.
