

Thank you for your interest in our Tobacco Treatment Program. The Health District of Northern Larimer County (Health District) includes the northern two-thirds of Larimer County. Those who live in the Health District can receive services on a sliding fee scale.

The following agreement is made between _____ (client) and the Health District.

Client agrees to:

- a. Enroll in the Health District's six session quit tobacco program for a \$ _____ fee to be paid in full no later than the 2nd session on this date _____.
- b. Pay the program fee before nicotine replacement therapy (nicotine gum, patches and/or lozenges) can be provided.
- c. Attend all sessions. Studies show that participating in counseling along with the use of medications, such as nicotine replacement therapy, Zyban or Chantix, greatly increases the chance of successfully quitting tobacco.
- d. Call 24 hours in advance to cancel a session. One "no show" will forfeit one session and corresponding free nicotine replacement. Two "no shows" forfeit remaining sessions and free nicotine replacement.

The Health District provides:

- a. After the six-session program, clients needing additional support to avoid relapse may schedule up to two free follow-up sessions, and may attend free support group sessions.
- b. Nicotine replacement therapy is provided free of charge during the six-session program for a maximum of 12 weeks, if nicotine replacement is appropriate for the client. In some cases we require a health-care provider's approval before we provide it.
- c. After 12 weeks, we may make additional nicotine replacement therapy available for purchase, at the same price we pay for it, to clients who need to continue using it, subject to availability.
